**Fire Lane:** No one is allowed to park, drop off, or pick up in the fire lane (marked by red paint) at any time of the day. If there is an emergency, as there was just yesterday, the entire fire lane must be clear for an ambulance and a fire truck, and potentially police cruisers. If there is a medical emergency, EMTs need to get into the building as quickly as possible. An emergency can happen at any time of the day. If you are parked in the fire lane, you will be asked to move. There are plenty of spaces to park in the rectory parking lot, the school parking lots, and along the street where there is no red paint on the curb. This is not just the school rule, parking in a fire lane is illegal.
