Reports

Principal Emily Finley shared news of a sizable donation to St. Bernard. Fr. Wittrock requested that the School Board generate a list of needs. Among the items discussed were the following: new windows, heating and AC upgrades, updated electrical, new security doors with fob and key system, additional phone lines within the building for emergency use, fire lane paint and signage update, crosswalk paint (luminescent), shatter-proof glass at front entrance, and installation fee for new gym AC unit (paid for already by Athletic Committee).

Miss Finley also reported that Home and School is financing and planning special events and gifts for the 8th grade class as they graduate. They will work in cooperation with Mrs. Pruitt.

The Pre-K Zoom roundup was a well-attended virtual event. As for retention rates between Pre-K and kindergarten, Miss Finley stated that the goal is 50 percent.

The current St. Bernard enrollment is 154 students; there has been an increase in sixth-grade students due to COVID.
