## UPDATES AND REMINDERS

**Cold Weather and Recess:** Winter is almost here, so please send your students to school in winter coats, hats, and gloves. **Christmas Program:** We have decided to do something a bit different for the Christmas program this year. We thought it would be special to have it in the church instead of in the school! Here are the important details for the program:

- Grades participating: PK-5 + Choir Club + Student Council
- Date: Friday, December 10th
- Time: 6:30 pm, starting with Mass, participants need to arrive no later than 6:15, but preferably earlier
  - Seating will be prioritized to immediate family first. There may not be room for extended family.
  - After 6:15, if there is extra space, extended family may sit.
  - Please be on time with your participant. Being late could result in no place for you to sit for the program.
- Choir Club will lead the Mass songs and the liturgy.
- Student Council members will be handing out books to families. Other middle school students may also come to help pass out books and earn volunteer hours.
- Participants need to come to Mass dressed in Sunday best: dresses or slacks. No jeans, sweatpants, leggings, shorts, etc. If students don't have this type of formal wear, they can wear their school uniform.

**Christmas Mass:** Middle school students are being asked to hand out books at the Christmas Masses. Middle school students still need to get volunteer hours, and this would be a great opportunity to get a few, especially if you plan on going to Mass anyway. We will need at least three, if not six, middle school students at each of the following Mass times: **5pm Christmas Eve, 10pm Christmas Eve, 9am Christmas Day.**

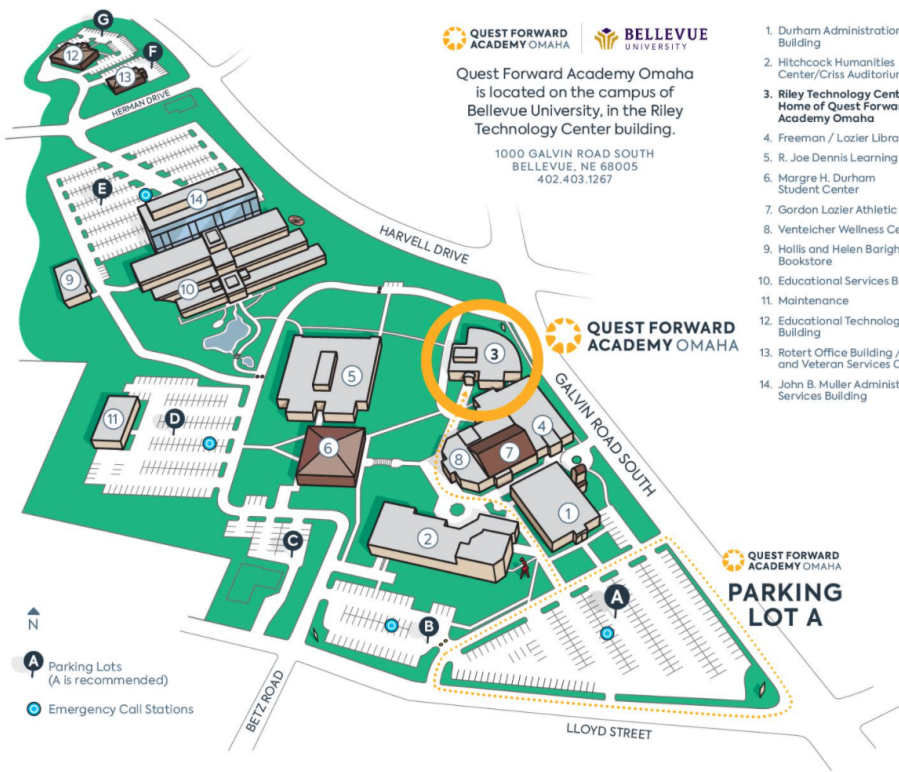
