UPDATES AND REMINDERS

News:

Pick Up: Lately, we have had more and more students not picked up in a timely manner. Students need to be picked up by 3:30 each day. We regularly have 5-10 students here at school until 3:45-4:00 which is after staff contracted hours. We understand that life happens sometimes, but if you do know you will be late, please give us a call to let us know your estimated time of arrival. If this continues and your child is 12 or under, we will require you to sign up for our after school care. Not only that, we are starting to see people picking up/dropping off in the fire lane again. I know the weather is getting colder, but students should be properly dressed to walk to the front door. You will be asked to move if you are picking up or dropping off in the fire lane.

Christmas Mass: Our Christmas Eve Masses have plenty of volunteers to hand out books. THANK YOU! To those who have volunteered. I will not be at every Mass, so if you have volunteered, I will send you and email with instructions before Christmas Eve. We are still in need of Christmas Day volunteers at 9 am. Reminders:

Smart Watches and AirPods: We have never had smart watches or wireless headphones become a distraction or be used inappropriately, however, we are seeing a lot of students not using these appropriately, so we will no longer allow wireless/bluetooth earbuds to be used without a teacher's approval for an educational reason and we will not

allow any smart watches. Not only have we found students listening to music throughout their entire day unbeknownst to their teachers, but any test that is taken while wearing a smart watch is null and void, especially the tests that are required of us by the state. If students are wearing wireless headphones without their teacher's approval, which would only be in the classroom, or if they are wearing a smartwatch, these will be confiscated until the end of the day for the first offense and students will earn a demerit or color change. The second offense, a parent will have to come pick up the item(s) and the student will earn a demerit or color change. After that, we will handle technology misuse on a case by case basis in accordance with our Technology Acceptable Use Policy signed at the beginning of the year.

Uniforms: Today is the first day after spirit wear pick up that students were required to be in uniform. Any student not wearing their correct uniform will be sent to the office to call home to send in their correct uniform. If they do not have a correct uniform, they will earn a demerit or color change for being out of uniform.

Hugs for Homebound: During this Advent season we enjoy time with friends and family, however, we have many parishioners who are not able to be with their friends and family as they are homebound. This is a hard time of year for people who are unable to leave their homes. They often feel alone and forgotten. Let's not let that happen this year. Please consider writing a Christmas card to our homebound parishioners. You can drop it off at school and the rectory will send them out. See the attached flyer for more details.

Cold Weather and Recess: Winter is about here, so please send your students to school in winter coats, hats, and gloves. Students will go outside for recess unless the outside temperature feels like 10 degrees or below. If they are not properly dressed they would have to miss out on recess time which is vital to a successful day of learning.

Christmas Program CHANGES: Because of a communication error between the school and church, the day of the Christmas program will be moved to **Thursday, December 16th.** Also, there has been a misunderstanding when it comes to seating. We will not be kicking anyone out, but arriving late may mean you don't get a seat and need to be standing room only. Participants need to arrive by 6:15, please! Your child will sit with you and be called to the sacristy when the group ahead of them is called up to perform. There will be an earlier rehearsal for those that can't make it at 2:00 pm in the Church. We will also be Zooming the later performance for any relatives that are unable to attend.
