Teaching Updates: I have two very important announcements about our staffing for next year.

- Mr. Becker has decided to leave teaching. We are actively searching for a music teacher, but, because of Mr. Becker's late resignation, we may have to start the year off without one. If you or someone you know would be willing to be a long-term sub, please contact me at 402-553-4993. Students will have art this year, so they will still have a creative special.
- The teacher shortage has affected us just like it has in every other school. We have been unsuccessful in hiring a middle school math and science teacher. Again, we are still actively looking for one, but if we don't find one or a long-term sub, here is our emergency plan. Currently, 6th and 7th grades have only 9-10 students. We would have 6th and 7th grade be a combined class, and Mr. Collier and Mrs. Sibbernsen would teach science and math. Again, this is the worst-case scenario. Please spread the word about the open positions here at school. If you have questions, please reach out to me.

New Teachers: While we are still looking for a few new teachers, we have filled all of our other positions, and I am excited to introduce them to you!

- Mrs. Maria Simonson: Pre-K. Has been a lead teacher in 3-4-year-old childcare classrooms for the past 11 years.
- Ms. Kate Fox: PE/Health. A first-year teacher with creative and new ideas for PE!

- 6:30 pm: 6th-8th grade parent meeting in the cafeteria with Ms. Finley. This information is for ALL families and not just new families. It is important that all families attend.
- All clubs/committees and used uniforms will be in the gym.
- Bring your students' school supplies to drop off in their room.

- Required handouts will be in your child's classroom. Please stop into their classroom, complete the required paperwork, and head to the gym to pay classroom fees (bring a check, cash, or card).
- We will have a TACO TRUCK outside for the night! Thank you to the school board and Brenda Davidson for getting this put together. Bring cash or card for the taco truck.

Construction and Cross Walk:

- The crosswalk has been moved to be right in front of the crosswalk sign where there is a walkway with no curb. There is paint still at the old crosswalk, but we will be using this new crosswalk. See the pictures below.
- There is construction on 65th and Pratt that is supposed to be done by August 9th. However, in the past week, I haven't seen any crew out there. If the construction isn't done by the first day of school, we will have to adjust our pick-up and drop-off procedures.





Free Lunches: For the last two years, all students have had free lunches, subsidized by the federal and state government because of Covid. The government is no longer having that rule in place, so student lunches will be charged again. Student lunch costs:

- \$3.00 for lunch
- just milk without lunch is \$0.55
- extras 6th-8th grade \$0.75 (only if there is money in the account)
- PreK milk \$0.20

You can add money to a student's lunch balance on Back to School Night. Make checks payable to St. Bernard and add in the memo line "Lunch Balance-(Student's Name)." You can also pay with cash. When your lunch balance is under \$5 you will get notifications via email and/or printed balance. **Families can still qualify for free and reduced lunches**. If you are close to or at the following income levels, I highly recommend filling out

the forms even if you don't plan on having your child get school lunches. Not only does this benefit you, but those forms determine the amount of funding we receive as a school. Every funding source or grant I apply for is typically needs-based and the free and reduced lunch rate is always the qualifier. Find the application here (Attachment C) or you will also receive them on Back to School Night. Below is the income chart for receiving free/reduced lunch. Please note that "household size" indicates every person living in your home; this includes all adults and all minors regardless if those adults or minors receive an income.
